Plurals In Arabic:

There are two types of plurals in Arabic:

- Solid Plural جَمع سَالِم (Jamea' Salem): Which we can form the plural using a very simple rules.
- Broken Plural جَمع تَكسِير (Jamea' Takseer): Which requires more complicated rules to form.

Rules of forming a solid plural:

- **Masculine Solid Plural** could be formed by adding $(\dot{\psi})$ or $(\dot{\psi})$ to the end of the noun (depending on the l'araab Form).
- Feminine Solid Plural could be formed by replacing the Taa Marbootah i with Note: .We can form a duel by adding () or () to the end of the noun (depending on the l'araab Form).
