"O Allah! For you did I fast and with your bounties did I break the fast." (Abu Dawood).

﴿ **DHA-HABADH-DHAMA 'U WAB-TALLATIL-UROOQU WA THABATAL-AJRU IN-SHA ALLAH**

"Gone is the thirst and moistured are the veins and achieved is the reward by the will of Allah." (Abu Dawood)
